



ICELAND VOLCANIC ASH CLOUD

When will SCTI agree to cover any further eruptions and/or ash clouds from the Eyjafjallajokull Iceland Volcano?

There will be provision to cover any new events that occur once the airspace affected by the Eyjafjallajokull Volcanic Ash cloud has been continuously open and operational for three months, from the date of 17th May 2010 (which is the date all airspace became operational).

So long as there are no eruptions or disruptions relating to the Eyjafjallajokull Iceland Volcano during the three month period, SCTI would deem any new events occurring after the 17th August 2010 to be unexpected.
